CFEE COVID-19 Protocols, Procedures, and Safety Measures

Pre-Event Vaccination: We now require all participants to be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 two weeks prior to travel. Please bring a copy of your vaccination information on the tour.

COVID Test Requirement: In light of the Delta variant and the uptick in COVID, we are requiring all in-person participants to either have taken and received a negative COVID test within the previous 72 hours or complete an on-site, ten minute rapid COVID test we will provide.

On-Site Rapid Testing: For all of our study tours, we now have available antigen nasal swabs for rapid testing of COVID-19 for any participants concerned they may be COVID positive.

Post-Event COVID-19 Testing: Following the program, we encourage all participants to minimize interaction with individuals outside their household until they have taken a follow-up COVID test 4-5 days after the event. Upon request, we will provide an antigen rapid test at the conclusion of the tour. We request to be notified promptly if they test positive, and we would then implement contact tracing for all fellow participants.

Health Questionnaire: In the days before the event, we send participants a health questionnaire, and we ask them to confirm their symptom-free status before joining.

Headsets: During suitable on-site visits and briefings, we provide headsets to allow for more physical distancing. This allows us to spread out farther from each other while still hearing presentations.

Temperature and Oxygen Readings: Throughout the program, we conduct regular temperature and blood oxygen checks to help participants monitor their well-being.

Sanitation and Masks: We make available to our participants our abundant supply of hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes. We also provide cloth masks to anyone who does not have their own. Masks may be mandatory in some instances.

Physically-Distanced Seating and Outdoor Gatherings: For our meeting rooms and meals, we may arrange physically distanced seating when practical. We may also incorporate virtual/hybrid components into our meetings along with arranging receptions and meals to be held in outdoor settings.

Hotel Procedures: We work with our hotel partners to understand and institute additional measures as needed. We examine protocols that will be applied to their entire property, their personnel, and other hotel guests. Frequent sanitation in highly trafficked areas, requiring staff to wear masks, and enhanced cleaning procedures for rooms are minimum requirements.
